ActionSA has been made aware that the City Integrity and Investigation Unit (CIU) has completed its investigations into the matter where the eThekwini Municipality signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the Durban International Convention Centre (ICC) to use tax-payer funds to pay for the African National Congress Women's League (ANCWL) elective conference.

However, our efforts to get our hands on the findings have been met with disinterest from the City manager Mr Musa Mbhele, after the report was submitted to his office.

Given that there is a council meeting tomorrow (09 November 2023), and the council is set to debate and vote on our motion to remove the Durban ICC Board Members, following their failure to act on our recommendations and report a case of corruption to the South African Police Service (SAPS).

Mr Mbhele's actions have led us to believing that this is merely a ploy to protect those who have been implicated in the findings.

However, one has to remind you, Mr Speaker that our actions aim to serve and protect the residents of eThekwini.

Making the report available will not only enable members of council to make well informed decisions in this matter, but it will also display your true leadership qualities, demonstrating that you have taken a stand to protect the residents of eThekwini from vultures who wish to loot coffers that should be delivering services to the people.

We advise that you prioritise this matter and ensue that the report is made available to all council members.
