Mr A D Beesley (ActionSA) to ask the Minister of Transport:

- (1) What (a) is the total number of employees of the Road Accident Fund (RAF) who are currently on suspension, (b) is the total cost to the RAF of the salaries and other remuneration paid to employees currently on suspension and (c) is the total amount paid to each employee from the date of suspension to the latest date for which information is available;
- (2) without providing any personally identifiable information of each employee, what are the relevant details of each employee who is currently on suspension in terms of (a) the date on which the suspension commenced, (b) whether the suspension is with or without pay, (c) the employee's current monthly salary and/or remuneration and (d) current status of any disciplinary, criminal or other proceedings relating to the suspension?
